




The Nest is tucked away in a lush valley on the private Namib Tsaris Conservancy (nee Neuhoof Nature Reserve), and it backs up against the great escarpment in the Namib Desert. This valley is a true desert oasis, boasting seasonal natural water pools and falls, and this makes it a magnet for the game moving through the area. A floodlit waterhole provides exciting and varied desert wildlife viewing as well as incredible birding. The Nest @ Sossus was designed using the unique structure of a Sociable Weaver nest as inspiration. It took eight years, including a three-year build, to bring this project to fruition and this has resulted in one of Namibia's most extraordinary private villas in terms of both design and décor. The Nest was designed by Porky Hefer, one of Africa's most awarded creative personalities, created by landscape conservationist Swen Bachran, and decorated by the up and coming Maybe Corpaci.

QUICK FACTS

- Open all year round, as of mid-April 2019.
- Hosted on an exclusive basis by one of Namibia's best naturalist guides, private butler and renowned gourmet chef.
- Best sold for groups of 4 guests up to maximum of 7 guests.
- The villa has 3 private en suite bedrooms (double beds) as well as an additional en suite kiddie's room. Each room is equipped with en-suite facilities with flush toilet and shower, fans, and electronic safe.
- Children very welcome.
- Fully inclusive package, including three meals a day (hot breakfast, freshly prepared lunch and a multiple course dinner), all local drinks and activities.
- Minimum of three nights which includes hot air ballooning, weather permitting (non-redeemable).

ACTIVITIES

- All activities are conducted in a private safari vehicle (specially modified Toyota Land Cruiser with air conditioning).
- Morning visits to Sossusvlei inclusive of a magic box picnic brunch.
- General exploration of the private Namib Tsaris Conservancy.
- Scenic guided nature walks and drives.
- Star gazing and night time photography.
- Drives up the plateau for some of the best views over the Namib Desert.
- Ballooning on a 3 night stay, or at optional at extra charge on a 2 night stay.
- Scenic flights at extra charge.
- Mountain Plus Biking (by prior arrangement only).

WHAT TO BRING

- An adventurous spirit and the desire to disconnect as you connect with nature.
- Camera equipment and binoculars – there are lots of exciting photographic opportunities available.
- Comfortable walking shoes with ankle support for scenic and adventurous hikes in the area.
- Well-fitting sandals.
- Hat, sunglasses and sunscreen.
- Bathing costume.
- Insect repellent (if you have a preference, otherwise supplied locally in the rooms).
- Light and durable clothing for hot days.
- Fleece or pullover for cool evenings and early mornings (suggest multipurpose clothing that offers wind, rain and cold protection in one).
- For the winter months (May to September) we recommend additional cold-weather gear such as beanie, scarf and gloves, possibly even thermal underwear.
- Please ensure you have completed the guest info document to assist us in making your stay with us more comfortable.

Amenities include: bath robes, slippers, liquid soap, body wash, shampoo and conditioner, body lotion, insect repellent, sewing kit, shower caps, vanity kit, tissue dispensers and laundry bags are supplied in each room. Laundry service is included.

Access to the camp is either by road from Windhoek or Swakopmund, or from any other nearby destination, or by light aircraft coming in to a nearby airstrip.
